Trees for Tomorrow: free trees for homeowners? Audobon Society offerings? Nature societies and organizations. Looking for free or discounted stuff for Lakewood.
- 5. Jim Walsh, also please contact area businesses for gift certificates for next year's picnic. If any other Board members have local connections, ask for gift cards.
- 6. We are looking for Jim to be our Research Director. There is always topics that we need information on especially for instance DNR laws/compliance and POA information.
- 7. Property Owner Steve Holmes volunteered to get more information on fund he knows of to give \$3000 in flowers to qualified applicants. He will fill out form and apply. Great low/no cost supplement to hill and north side of ramp if we are accepted. Maureen will follow up with Steve to see what he learned.
